

Argentière is nestled at the foot of the Argentière glacier and the Spectacular <u>Aiguille Verte</u> peak. It is full of Savoyarde charm and ancient buildings. The centre of the village is dominated by a baroque-style church which was built in the 18th century so that villagers could come together in prayer. In the winters it was impossible to make the journey to Chamonix Mont-Blanc to pray, so the church was built in the village to allow the residents to worship whatever the weather. When the church was built, the glacier reached down just behind it! You will see now how far it has receded.

The old village of Argentière has all the typical charm of a mountain village and harks back to the early conquests of Mont Blanc. Similarly, heading further up the valley towards Switzerland you will arrive at Le Tour and then Vallorcine – both a little more fixed in the past and both offering a unique insight into life in the mountains hundreds of years ago. Both are sometimes still cut off from the rest of the valley during the winter months.

Les <u>Grands Montets ski area</u> makes Argentière a must-visit destination for winter sports fans from around the world. The Off Piste and extreme skiing opportunities are superb. The wild and spectacular character of the mountain is perfect for mountaineers and hikers in summer and for cross-country skiers in winter.

A <u>number of hiking paths</u> start out from Argentière: for example, you can climb up to <u>Lac Blanc</u> which affords stunning views of <u>Mont Blanc</u>, or walk to Chamonix-Mont-Blanc via the wonderful Petit Balcon Sud.





USE YOUR CARTE D'HÔTE

Your Cart D'Hôte is personal to you and will be dated for the duration of your stay. You can use it to get discounts at some museums and at the sports centre in Chamonix, but most importantly it allows you to ride the train for free between SERVOZ and VALLORCINE.

Note that your Cart D'Hôte does NOT allow to ride the bus, although you can use it to pay a discounted rate. To ride the bus for free, you must have a lift pass.

Neither a Cart D'Hôte nor a lift pass will be accepted on the night buses – you will ALWAYS have to pay.

Getting AROUND



USE PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Argentière is very well connected to the rest of the valley. It is situated on the main (only) road between Chamonix and Vallorcine and onwards into Switzerland, should you wish to go further afield. It is served by both bus and train which run very frequently in both the summer and winter seasons. Please be aware that the timetables change according to the time of year. Chamonix has recently introduced smart tracking for all of its buses – use this link:

GET TO KNOW THE NUMBER 2 BUS

The Number 2 bus runs from Le Tour (at the top of the valley) to Chamonix. It is the most useful bus for moving around in both summer and winter, although it can get very crowded. In high season it runs very frequently and in the winter it shares the roads with various dedicated Ski buses. If the bus is full then the driver WILL NOT stop, unless they are letting someone disembark. If this happens, do not panic, another will be along very shortly.

Buses are free on showing your ski lift pass.

The best advice is to get out early, before 1000, and try to avoid lunchtimes and 1600 as this is when the whole bus network is very busy.





Your Carte D'Hôte allows you to use the train between Servoz and Vallorcine for free. The trains are generally less crowded than the buses and are a relaxing and fun way to travel.

Argentière has its own train station only 500m from the chalet. As with the buses, the train timetables change depending on the season. Use your Chamonix app to quickly access the most up to date information.









DO NOT MISS

Chamonix is a vibrant town boasting spectacular views, world beating skiing and unparalled trekking, hiking and mountaineering possibilities. Nestled between the Mont Blanc Massif and the Aiguilles Rouges Mountain ranges you cannot fail to find exciting and exhilarating things to do – whatever time of year. Here are some highlights.



AIGUILLE DU MIDI

Travel to the top of the world on the Aiguille Du Midi cable car – the highest in France. This is the most spectacular experience and cannot be missed. If you dare - Step into the void and experience the beauty of the high mountains. The Summit of Mont Blanc is just 1000m above you, the town of Chamonix is 2842m below you!

MONTENVERS CHEMIN DE FER - MER DE GLACE

Take the rack and pinion train to the station of Montenvers at 1913m altitude. You will have an unforgettable 20 minute ride to the station where you have spectacular views of the famous Mer de Glace Glacier and Les Grandes Jorasses. Take the cable car down to La Grotte de Glace and walk into the glacier, visit the crystal caves and marvel in the beauty of nature. If you take the steps down, you can see the reduction in the level of the glacier over the years – remember, in 1920 the glacier was level with the train station – it is now far below accessed by the cable car and stairs! https://www.montblancnaturalresort.com/fr/montenvers-mer-de-glace



CHAMONIX SATURDAY MARKET

VIsit the farmers market, every Saturday farmers and Artisans from across the Haute Savoie hold a huge market in the iconic Place Du Mont Blanc. You can buy anything from local food, meats, cheeses, vegetables to cowskin rugs and cow bells!



ARGENTIÈRE SUNDAY MARKET

Every Sunday in High Season the farmers and artisans hold a market in the centre of the village. Do not miss the roast chicken and potatoes – the best in the valley!



ACTIVITIES

TREKKING, HIKING AND TRAIL RUNNING

Directly from the Chalet you can access beautiful and challenging treks, ranging from a couple of hours to all day. You can even follow routes that are part of the Tour Du Mont Blanc. One of our favourites is from the centre of Argentière to Col de Montets – then on to Le Tour, return on foot or by bus!

Another day walk incorporates lunch at a locally famous buvette – La buvette du Chapeau.

Or try your stamina with a hike up to Lac Blanc.

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Not for the faint hearted, mountain biking in the Chamonix valley is extremely challenging and requires a full set of protective gear, extreme sports insurance is recommended. The lifts are configured to carry bikes up the mountains to make access simple and quick so that you can enjoy your time riding down rather than up!

E-BIKING

Still challenging in this terrain, but extremely popular – the routes generally follow the footpaths, so you will encounter pedestrians, however the experience of riding through cool shade of the dense forests which cover both sides of the valley is unbelievable.

WHITE WATER RAFTING (GUIDED)

Paddle the torrent that is L'Arve from Tennis Parking at Chamonix down the valley to your pickup point. Whizz through the centre of Chamonix itself and continue down through unspoilt areas on your journey. The water is cold, but hopefully you will not fall in.

CANYONING (GUIDED)

Don a wetsuit and booties and gloves and descend waterfalls in secluded areas of the valley. Take jumps into plunge pools and scramble over rocks, experience the sheer power of the mountains and the water directly as you descend the often steep terrain in the river canyon.

PARAPENTING

Take to the skies with an experienced tandem pilot. Take the cable car up, strap in and run with your instructor off the mountain! Fly like a bird and enjoy this unique way to experience the mountains.

ACCROPARK

Take the train to Les Gaillands and spend a morning, afternoon or a day at the Accropark – climb, jump, swing over and around graded courses – overcome your fear of heights – build your confidence - a great family day out.

CLIMBING

It goes without saying that you can climb in the valley – the options are almost limitless and can suit all abilities.

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ACTIVITIES

Experience some of the best Skiing in the Alpes! Chamonix is NOT a fully linked resort, but it does cater for all abilities. Some of the best beginner slopes are located at La Vormaine, Le Tour, just a short bus ride from the Le FIS bus stop at the top of the village. For intermediate and advanced skiers, you simply cannot want for a more stunning location to play in!

There are 5 main ski areas:

Les Grand Montets – walk approximately 750m to access this spectacular area of the Mont Blanc Massif. Challenging skiing, North facing, this area promises exceptional skiing and even more spectacular views. Take a rest at the quirky Comptoir à Raclette and enjoy the atmosphere, the DJ the food and the view!

Le Tour/Vallorcine – Take the bus to le tour from Le FIS bus stop or take the train to Vallorcine to enjoy this huge open area bordering Switzerland at the Croix de Fer. Be sure to check your Chamonix App for the linked lift status! If in doubt, just get the bus to Le Tour. Once there you have a commanding view of the whole valley from the top down with Mont Blanc and the Mont Blanc Massive on your left and the Aiguilles Rouges on your right. Chamonix is nestled in the centre of your view! You will find wide open and often deserted pistes. This is not because it is not busy, but simply because it is so big! When there you must visit our favourite Mountain restaurant, L'Alpage de Balme. Sit inside out of the wind or reserve a place on the terrace and soak up the winter sun.

La Flegère – The suntrap of the valley! Cruise down some gentle Blues and Greens or challenge yourself with the Reds and Blacks – get a different perspective of the valley and marvel at Mon Blanc, Kles Grands Jorasses and Les Drus. To get there, take the bus (Number 2 or the seasonal SkiBuses) to Les Praz/ La Flegère. You will see the state of the art ski lift station which will take you to this stunning area. You can link from here to Les Brevants via the breathtaking Brevants Telecabine.

Brevants – Linked with La Flegère this area provides yet more challenges for you which you will not regret!

Les Houches – further down the valley you will find Les Houches. A charming village with good facilities and a variety of ski slopes – although lower and therefore not as snow sure, the skiing is good with many pistes running through the trees.

VALLEE BLANCHE test your nerve with a guided off piste descent of La Mer de Glace down the INFAMOUS Vallee Blanche!! If you have the skills then this is an absolute must, a classic and a descent to put down in your personal history book!!! Please note that Chamonix Guides are not the only guiding company.
