About **ARGENTIERE**

Argentière is nestled at the foot of the Argentière Glacier and the spectacular summit of the Aiguille Verte. This village is full of Savoyard charm and old buildings. The village center is dominated by a baroque-style church built in the 18th century to allow the villagers to gather in prayer. In winter, it was impossible to make the journey to Chamonix Mont-Blanc for prayer, which is why the church was erected in the village, allowing the locals to gather year-round. At the time of its construction, the glacier reached just behind the church! You will now see how much it has retreated.

The old village of Argentière has all the typical charm of a mountain village and recalls the early conquests of Mont Blanc. Continuing your journey towards Switzerland, you will arrive at Le Tour, then Vallorcine, two places deeply rooted in the past, offering a unique glimpse into mountain life several centuries ago. These villages are sometimes still cut off from the rest of the valley during the winter months.

The Grands Montets ski area makes Argentière a must-visit destination for winter sports enthusiasts from all over the world. The off-piste and extreme skiing possibilities are superb. The wild and spectacular character of the mountain is perfect for climbers and hikers in summer, and for cross-country skiers in winter. Several hiking trails depart from Argentière: for example, you can climb to Lac Blanc, which offers breathtaking views of Mont Blanc, or walk towards Chamonix-Mont-Blanc via the beautiful Petit Balcon Sud.

Things TO DO



DO NOT MISS

Chamonix is a vibrant town boasting spectacular views, world beating skiing and unparalleled trekking, hiking and mountaineering possibilities. Nestled between the Mont Blanc Massif and the Aiguilles Rouges Mountain ranges you cannot fail to find exciting and exhilarating things to do – whatever time of year. Here are some highlights.



AIGUILLE DU MIDI

Travel to the top of the world on the Aiguille Du Midi cable car – the highest in France. This is the most spectacular experience and cannot be missed. If you dare – Step into the void and experience the beauty of the high mountains. The Summit of Mont Blanc is just 1000m above you, the town of Chamonix is 2842m below you!

MONTENVERS CHEMIN DE FER – MER DE GLACE

Take the rack and pinion train to the station of Montenvers at 1913m altitude. You will have an unforgettable 20 minute ride to the station where you have spectacular views of the famous Mer de Glace Glacier and Les Grandes Jorasses. Take the cable car down to La Grotte de Glace and walk into the glacier, visit the crystal caves and marvel in the beauty of nature. If you take the steps down, you can see the reduction in the level of the glacier over the years – remember, in 1920 the glacier was level with the train station – it is now far below accessed by the cable car and stairs!

Getting AROUND



USE PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Argentière is very well connected to the rest of the valley. It is situated on the main (only) road between Chamonix and Vallorcine and onwards into Switzerland, should you wish to go further afield. It is served by both bus and train which run very frequently in both the summer and winter seasons. Please be aware that the timetables change according to the time of year. Chamonix has recently introduced smart tracking for all of its buses – use this link:

GET TO KNOW THE NUMBER 2 BUS

The Number 2 bus runs from Le Tour (at the top of the valley) to Chamonix. It is the most useful bus for moving around in both summer and winter, although it can get very crowded. In high season it runs very frequently and in the winter it shares the roads with various dedicated Ski buses. If the bus is full then the driver WILL NOT stop, unless they are letting someone disembark. If this happens, do not panic, another will be along very shortly. Buses are free on showing your ski lift pass.

The best advice is to get out early, before 1000, and try to avoid lunchtimes and 1600 as this is when the whole bus network is very busy.



USE THE TRAIN

Your Carte D'Hôte allows you to use the train between Servoz and Vallorcine for free. The trains are generally less crowded than the buses and are a relaxing and fun way to travel.

Argentière has its own train station only 500m from the chalet. As with the buses, the train timetables change depending on the season. Use your Chamonix app to quickly access the most up to date information.



Winter ACTIVITIES

DISCOVER THE BEST OF SKIING IN THE ALPS!

Chamonix is not an entirely connected resort, but it caters to all levels. Some of the best slopes for beginners are located at La Vormaine, at Le Tour, just a few minutes by bus from the Le FIS bus stop at the top of the village. For intermediate and advanced skiers, you couldn't dream of a more spectacular place to indulge in your passion!

There are 5 main ski areas:

Les Grands Montets

– Walk about 750 meters to access this spectacular area of the Mont Blanc Massif. Difficult skiing, north-facing, this area promises exceptional skiing and even more spectacular views. Take a break at the Comptoir à Raclette, a unique spot where you can enjoy the atmosphere, the DJ, the food, and the view!

Le Tour/Vallorcine

– Take the bus to Le Tour from the Le FIS bus stop, or take the train to Vallorcine to enjoy this vast open area bordering Switzerland at Croix de Fer.

Make sure to check the lift status on your Chamonix app! If in doubt, simply take the bus to Le Tour. Once there, you'll have a breathtaking view of the whole valley from above, with Mont Blanc and the Mont Blanc Massif on your left and the Aiguilles Rouges on your right. Chamonix is nestled in the center of your view! You'll find wide slopes, often deserted. It's not because they are less frequented, but simply because it's so vast! During your stay, be sure to visit our favorite mountain restaurant, L'Alpage de Balme. Settle inside to shelter from the wind or reserve a spot on the terrace and enjoy the winter sun.

La Flégère

– The sunny spot in the valley! Ski down the gentle blue and green slopes or challenge yourself with red and black runs – get a different perspective of the valley and admire Mont Blanc, the Grands Jorasses, and the Drus. To get there, take the bus (Number 2 or the seasonal SkiBuses) to Les Praz/La Flégère. You will see the state-of-the-art lift station that will take you to this beautiful area. From here, you can connect to Les Brévents via the spectacular Brévents cable car.

Winter ACTIVITIES

Les Brévents

– Connected to La Flégère, this area offers even more challenges that you won't regret!

Les Houches

– Further down the valley, you'll find Les Houches. A charming village with good facilities and a variety of ski slopes – although lower and therefore less reliable in terms of snow, skiing here is enjoyable with many runs winding through the trees.

VALLEE BLANCHE

Test your courage with a guided off-piste descent of La Mer de Glace in the INFAMOUS Vallée Blanche! If you have the skills, this is a must-do, a classic, and a descent to add to your personal history book! Please note that Chamonix Guides is not the only guiding company.

PARAGLIDING

Paragliding offers an exciting way to experience the beauty of the landscape from an aerial perspective, soaring over mountains, valleys, and lakes. This adventure sport combines the thrill of flight with the tranquility of gliding through the air, propelled only by the wind and updrafts. Whether you're a beginner with a tandem flight or an experienced pilot, paragliding provides an unforgettable feeling of freedom and exhilaration.

SNOWSHOEING

Snowshoeing is a wonderful way to explore snowy trails and immerse yourself in a winter wonderland. This activity is accessible to all fitness levels and requires minimal equipment: a pair of snowshoes and sturdy shoes. Snowshoeing allows you to venture into pristine areas, offering a peaceful and serene experience in nature.

ACCESS TO SKI SLOPES

To reach the slopes, the nearest bus stop to the chalet is next to the U supermarket. You need to get off at the Les Grands Montets stop.



SKI RENTAL

Sportech – 350 meters from the chalet, the closest to the chalet. This store is about to open an extension of its ski rental service. It will likely offer the best selection of equipment.

352 Rue Charlet Straton, Argentière – 74400 Chamonix-Mont-Blanc, just above the supermarket.

Namaste – 450 meters from the chalet, the most friendly and great for ski touring. Rachael has worked there before. This store also has a small bar for après-ski, so it's also a social spot.

141 Rue Charlet Straton, Argentière – 74400 Chamonix-Mont-Blanc, right across from the UCPA.

Sanglard – 750 meters from the chalet, the closest to the Grands Montets, right at the bottom of the Plan Joran cable car. The most convenient if you need to exchange equipment after skiing on the slopes.

98 Chemin de la Glacière, Téléphérique des Grands Montets, Argentière – 74400 Chamonix-Mont-Blanc.

SKIMAX – 1.4 km from the chalet. A very good store, but a bit farther from the chalet – it is located on the road that leads up to the Grands Montets parking lot.

Summer ACTIVITIES

TREKKING, HIKING AND TRAIL RUNNING

Directly from the Chalet you can access beautiful and challenging treks, ranging from a couple of hours to all day. You can even follow routes that are part of the Tour Du Mont Blanc. One of our favourites is from the centre of Argentière to Col de Montets – then on to Le Tour, return on foot or by bus!

One of the websites to visit is this one: Chamonix.net, but a simple search will bring up many more.

Another day walk incorporates lunch at a locally famous buvette – La buvette du Chapeau.

Or try your stamina with a hike up to [Lac Blanc](#).

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Not for the faint hearted, mountain biking in the Chamonix valley is extremely challenging and requires a full set of protective gear, extreme sports insurance is recommended. The lifts are configured to carry bikes up the mountains to make access simple and quick so that you can enjoy your time riding down rather than up!

E-BIKING

Still challenging in this terrain, but extremely popular – the routes generally follow the footpaths, so you will encounter pedestrians, however the experience of riding through cool shade of the dense forests which cover both sides of the valley is unbelievable.

WHITE WATER RAFTING (GUIDED)

Paddle the torrent that is L'Arve from Tennis Parking at Chamonix down the valley to your pickup point. Whizz through the centre of Chamonix itself and continue down through unspoilt areas on your journey. The water is cold, but hopefully you will not fall in.

CANYONING (GUIDED)

Don a wetsuit and booties and gloves and descend waterfalls in secluded areas of the valley. Take jumps into plunge pools and scramble over rocks, experience the sheer power of the mountains and the water directly as you descend the often steep terrain in the river canyon.

PARAPENTING

Take to the skies with an experienced tandem pilot. Take the cable car up, strap in and run with your instructor off the mountain! Fly like a bird and enjoy this unique way to experience the mountains.

ACCROPARK

Take the train to Les Gaillands and spend a morning, afternoon or a day at the Accropark – climb, jump, swing over and around graded courses – overcome your fear of heights – build your confidence – a great family day out.

CLIMBING

It goes without saying that you can climb in the valley – the options are almost limitless and can suit all abilities.
